WHAT IS MURNInets 2.0?

- ❑ An acronym of "Malaysian Urban Rural National Indicators Network for Sustainable Development".
- ❑ A tool to assess the performance and sustainability level of local authorities in Malaysia.
- ❑ It enables local, state and national government to collect, store, analyse, evaluate, manage and display data relating to sustainability.
- ❑ The operation of MURNInets is headed by the Ministry of Federal Territories and the main secretariat is PLANMalaysia.

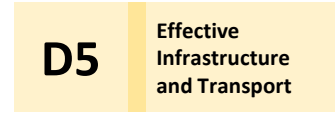
WHAT IS MURNInets 2.0?

- ❑ The Research and Development Division in PLANMalaysia acts as the National MURNInets Operation Center.
- ❑ MURNInets had operated from 2012 to 2016.
- ❑ In 2017, MURNInets was revised to be inline with the current national policies and various sustainability indicators at the international level.
- ❑ The revised version of MURNInets is called MURNInets 2.0, and starts to operate on 1 January 2018.
- ❑ MURNInets 2.0 has improved with new indicators and a more structured reporting method.
